in the St. Nicholas Church of Znojmo 8 th of December 2007

For nearly two years now the Viennese artist, social- and sexual scientist Mag. Dr. Rainer König-Hollerwöger, president of IPS-Vienna with an office in Znojmo, has been working in the Austrian-Czech border region.

He has been the main initiator of the EU-opening conference concerning Austria, Germany and the Czech Republic held in March 17, 2007.

In the evening of the same day, he being a friend and lover of the Czech arts and culture played the concert "ORGEL SPONTAN 2005/06" in the St. Nikolaus Church of Znojmo to which he dedicated the concert to. Parts of the donations for the concert he donated himself to the famous church of St. Nicholas.

In his deep bindings to the Czech Republic and the city of Znojmo the international organist, author and painter Dr. Rainer König-Hollerwöger this year will dedicate to his friends and colleagues a very special Christmas concert in December 2007. He will improvise on the organ over world known Christmas songs out of the moment of inspiration of the special location of the St. Nicholas church. Transformed into symphonic poetry, preludes and concert fugues these Christmas melodies will sound as a further step into the Christmassy mystic of the location.

As founder of the international initiative "IJJ 06" for searching and finding the seventeen year old Julia K. from Pulkau near Retz at the lower Austrian and Czech border who has been missing since one and a half years, Dr. Rainer König-Hollerwöger wants to set a further international sign for the search of Julia with this concert.

Also he will give a speech previous to the concert in the St. Nicholas Church. The soon coming up opening of the passengers' control at the border between Austria and the Czech Republic should as well be greeted with this for the intention of the Viennese scientist, researcher and artist is to build up the relations, intercultural and interdisciplinary communications between Austria and the Czech Republic and to reduce the fear of contact that might come up by this.

In the up coming year of 2008 Mag. Dr. Rainer König-Hollerwöger will present to the international public his book of Europe, a multi layered European work of pioneer of two years time.

The Mayor of Znojmo Ing. Petr Nezveda and the Mayor of Pulkau Manfred Marihart will make a speech. The community with its people, under which the police of Znojmo, as well as the Austrian, Czech and international medias will be invited to this concert. The introduction will be in the Czech and Austrian language.

For the intermission a get together will be arranged in the parsonage of the St. Nicholas Church. Hot tea and cake will be served.
