# Extra-ordinary SUMMER CONCERT JULIA ORGEL SPONTANEOUS INTERNATIONAL VIENNA 2008 Mag. Dr. Rainer König-Hollerwöger

This intercultural interdenominational international organ concert will be given by the Viennese artist, scientist and researcher Mag. Dr. Rainer König-Hollerwöger in the Lutheran Church "Dorotheerkirche", Protestant parish A. B., Vienna - City Center. The event will be opened with a speech by Referend Dr. Ines Knoll.

On the one hand this extra-ordinary organ concert is dedicated to the vivid remembrance and praying for Julia Kührer from Pulkau/ Lower Austria and all the missing children/ adolescents and their worried families in all Europe and internationally.

It will set a further sign of life for missing Julia K. in Vienna. Julia disappeared withourt a trace on the 27 June 2006. She was sixteen, then. Julia has been missing for two years now. Supposed sights of Julia were recorded in Vienna, but unfortunately this information did not lead to useful traces for further research so far.

On the other hand this concert is dedicated to the missing Jewish children and adolescent of the Nazi-era that have been tortured, maltreated and often murdered.

This event is an interdenominational event with delivered words of greetings by Dr. Heinz Fischer, Federal President of the Austrian Republic, and Dr. Ariel Muzicant, President of the Federal Association of Jewish Congregations in Austria. Speeches about their imprisonment in the concentration camps will be dilivered by: Erika Bezdíčková, journalist, and the technician Michal Salomonovič, Historian Auschwitz Group Prague, Board of the Jewish Congregations, concerned with raising awareness and reconciliation.

Misses Bezdíčková is "Honorary President Southeast and Central Europe" and "Head of the advisory Council on international questions concerning Southeast and Central Europe and bridges of remembrance between the past and the present" of IPS-WIEN. (www.ips-wien.at - the institute/ team)

As president of IPS-WIEN working on a two years research project concerning the Austrian-Czech border region, Germany and Prague financed by the EU, Dr. Rainer König-Hollerwöger launched the **international initiative "IIJ 06"** for searching and finding Julia K. The Viennese philosopher of art, musician, scientist and researcher Dr. Rainer König-Hollerwöger was born 1957 in Gmunden - Traunsee in Upper Austria.

With his creative work in the fields of art, science and psychosocial work he breaks new ground. The main approach of his researching and creating is to use the dynamic of diverse metamorphoses that arise momentarily. He intents to develop out of a *particular cultural*, *social*, *psychic and scenic setting* the *adequate artisitic form*.

For the last two years, functioning as president of IPS-WIEN, he has been working on an EU-project concerning Austria, the Czech Republic and Germany. In September 2008 a comprehensive "Europe Book" about his international research work will be published.

Rainer König-Hollerwöger is father of three children aged 22, 27 and 28. His works as a composer comprise compositions for stringed bowed instruments, wind instruments, piano, percussion, organ, as well as Lieder with his own lyrics. His works as a writer comprises lyric poetry, plays and narrations. Prints of his painted works can be found in his books.
