The Viennese all- round artist, social researcher and scientist is already giving his second concert on the oldest organ of Cesky Krumlov dating back to the 17<sup>th</sup> century (Extraordinary Christmas Concert JULIA - ČESKÝ KRUMLOV 2009, ORGEL SPONTAN ČESKÝ KRUMLOV 1309-2009).

The old mystical church will be filled with the glooming tunes of fall. Francis of Assisi (1181/82-1226) medieval poetry "Canticle of the Sun" is transformed into poetical organ music.

The enchanting City of Český Krumlov in South Bohemia and Egon Schiele`s art are transformed into organ music.

A suite especially composed describes the mystic and occult of Eleonore of Schwarzenberg (1682-1741) in musical art.

Johann Sebastian Bach`s (1685-175) next to last composition "The Art of Fugue" was the source of inspiration to the "Metamorphoses of the Art of Fugue" and the "PRAELUDIUM ET FUGA SPONTAN B-A-C-H.
